

Apathy alert

I talked last week about repentance. (Specifically, David's repentance.)

But forgiveness does not eliminate consequences. (In 2 Samuel 13-14 this is evident)

- Amnon and his stepsister Tamar. (He made himself sick with his desire.) Absalom and Tamar had the same mother, but not Amnon.
- Amnon plotted a rape that David could have prevented.
- Amnon then "hated her" and shunned and shamed her.
- David was notified and it made him mad but took no course of action! (We cannot turn a blind eye to our children in dealing with things.)
- Absalom, another sibling is infuriated. (Understandable) But kills Amnon and then flees the kingdom.
- Where was David's zeal for his own house? (Can't get old and callous!)
- In 14, we see Absalom return but David does not want to see him.
- Then David half-heartedly forgives Absalom. (Forgiveness does not occur half-heartedly.) This will be a problem that we will see later.



Their just seems to be less fervor in David's life. (The consequence of sin can really wear a person down!

So can life. It can drain us of the energy that we need to serve God!

In a church we see let down. In marriages. In our "holy ambitions"! Look at these two churches...

Revelation 3:2–3 (ESV) (Church at Sardis)


²Wake up, and strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have not found your works complete in the sight of my God.

³Remember, then, what you received and heard. Keep it, and repent. If you will not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come against you.

Revelation 3:16 (ESV)

¹⁶So, because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth.

- Verse 19 says "to be zealous and repent." (Find your way back to zeal!)

- In Jonah chapter 4, <u>Jonah</u> doesn't want to join God in forgiveness. (**He wants to hang on to his anger and hatred. Asks to die!**)
- In Mark 10:21, the rich young ruler goes away sad- can't give all to Jesus!
- Numbers 14:2-4 Israel wandered in the wilderness/40 years/wondered if captivity was better than freedom in Christ!
- The changing world system- (2 Timothy 4:3-4) Paul tells Timothy stay with truth!



4. Avoid complacent- (you are not finished and aren't an expert Christian!) No you haven't found something better!

⁹And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. Hebrews 5:11–12 (ESV)

- 5. Faith requires action! (Hebrews 11:6- "Without faith it is impossible to please God.) God responds to our reach for Him!
 - a.) Gratitude, prayer and meditation, study and discipleship, witness and testimony!
- (O) 6. Develop your love for God! (The relationship is as good as what you invest!) Colossians 3:22-24 (ESV)

²²Bondservants, obey in everything those who are your earthly masters, not by way of eyeservice, as people-pleasers, but with sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord.

²³Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men,

7. Encourage others with your presence- (Christianity is serving, not being served.) It reciprocates!

²⁴And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,

²⁵not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.
